Shalom from the Sasser Family. Our stay in Israel was very short this time. We were only there for about two weeks before the country began to close down because of the Covid-19 pandemic. However, I was amazed at the many opportunities that arose for us during that short time.

Our Uber ministy (That is the first name that comes to my mind) led us to some great endeavors of getting out the gospel. I try to get out and pick-up hitchhikers during the times that people would be going to and from work. In the area we live in in Israel there are a lot of very religious Jewish people. The combination of being kind and giving them a ride and no other Jewish person around them makes for the chance to give them the gospel. One man who was a Rabbi stayed in the car with me for over an hour once we arrived at his house. Of course, during that time he was trying to convince me of the truth as he sees it; but Praise the Lord, he also listened as I opened up the Old Testament and showed him Jesus. I will say it was very challenging for me since his English was very poor, but I was able to speak to him in Hebrew enough that he understood. God promises that His word will not return void!!!

Another afternoon, we picked up a woman from a kibbutz (community) just about five miles from where we live. As I began to witness to her, she told me that she believes in Jesus. It became apparent in our conversation that she has not been saved nor even understood what salvation was. She listened intently and invited us to come to the kibbutz that she lives in to speak. She said that she would get some people lined-up to come to listen to me as I shared with them what I was sharing with her. Unfortunately, this was just a couple of days before the country went into lockdown. Praise the Lord, we did get her contact information so as soon as we can, we will follow up on this.

We are shocked at what we are seeing take place in our country over this coronavirus. We are praying for you pastors, for wisdom and guidance through this very difficult time.
